Notification of bingo prizes in excess of \$20,000

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

A community or charitable organisation or a bingo centre operator who intends to conduct a session of bingo at which the total prizes for the session will or is likely to exceed \$20,000 must notify the Victorian Gambling and Casino Control Commission (the VGCCC) in writing of that intention at least three business days before conducting the session.

False or misleading information

It is an offence under the Gambling Regulation Act 2003 (the Act) to give information that is false or misleading. If you give false or misleading information, you may be prosecuted and fined up to 60 penalty units. The current value of a penalty unit can be obtained at vgccc.vic.gov.au
